

Selkirk Habitat Restoration work days

Volunteers are needed Aug. 19, 20 and 21 to work with Forest Service staff to protect the North Tarryall Creek in Selkirk basin. The South Park Ranger District has identified a growing problem with dispersed camping and illegal motorized travel that is invading the headwaters of the creek adjacent to Selkirk Campground. These activities are causing increased sedimentation, significant erosion and damaging impacts to the flora and fauna of this area.

Work includes installation of post and cable fencing, installation of two seasonal gates, and raking of native grass seeds into affected areas.

Come just for one or all days. Lunch and snacks provided. Overnight camping near the project with dinner and breakfast provided.
